

How to record animal movements

The NLMD-LT records the movements of animals between holdings. Movements are recorded to trace animals, meet legislation and complete online holding registers.

1. Log into NLMD-LT, under the **Manage Animals** menu option, select **Transfer /Move Animals**



2. Select the direction of movement. **Movement On** is to record animals moving onto your holding. **Movement Off** is to record animals moving off your holding.

3. Use the dropdowns to select a departure and a destination holding. For a holding you haven't used before, select **Other**. Type in the Holding number (using the correct format 11/111/1111) and hit **<Enter>** on your keyboard. Click the **Edit** button to enter the holding details.

4. Choose the movement date and species. If the species is sheep or goat then you will have an option to create and print a movement document. Untick the box if you don't need movement documents. Click **Next** to continue.

5. Enter the details of the animals that are moving. You can enter individual animal identifiers, batch numbers and quantities, or both. Individual animals can be entered in the text box provided, one

identifier per line. For off-movements, individual animals can be selected from the list of known animals on your holding.

You can also add batch details for animals that are not individually identified or for movements that do not require individual records. To record batch details, enter the batch number, the total animals and then click the **Add Batch** button. To remove a batch, click the **Remove batch from list** button next to the batch details to delete.

When all the animal details are entered, click **Next** to continue.

Move Animals

This is the second step in recording a movement.

You need to type in either the RFID numbers or the visual tag numbers of the animals you want to transfer

- or better, copy and paste the information from your EID reader file.

Enter the number of animals being moved, which should match the total individual and batch identified animals entered on the previous screen. You can optionally enter details about the movement document and haulier.

Click next to submit the movement request.
