

# How to Administer Medicine to Dogs, Cats & Other Farm Pets

You can use NLMD-LT to record the treatment of dogs, cats and other farm pets. These treatments will appear in your online medicine book.

After logging into NLMD-LT, under the **Manage Holdings** menu, select **Administer Medicine to Dogs & Pets**.



When the screen first loads it will display the treatment history for dogs & other farms pet over the last 6 months. You can filter and sort this list to find particular treatments. To remove a previous treatment, click the associated **Undo** button.

## Recording a New Treatment

To record a new treatment, click the **Record New Treatment** button and you will be presented with the following screen:

1. First select the holding CPH where the treatment was performed and set the treatment start and end dates.
2. Enter the name or description of the animal being treated.
3. Now select the medicine being administered from the grid. You must have previously purchased the medicine via the Medicine Stock screen and when purchased, the medicine must have 'Can be used on Dogs, Cats and other farm pets' ticked.
4. Next enter the dosage per animal and optionally enter who administered the treatment and the condition / reason for treatment.
5. Finally click the **Save** button to record the treatment.
